



# ECONOMICS

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS (does not guarantee acceptance)

At least 52 completed hours with a 2.5 GPA on all work attempted\*, and “C” grades or better in:

- ECO2013 and ECO2023 (6 hours)
- MAC1105, 2233, or 2311 (3 hours)
- STA2023 or STA 2122 (3 hours)

\* Beginning Fall 2024, admissions to the major will:

- No longer require a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Require a prerequisite GPA of 2.5 or higher across the courses listed above.

## MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

39 hours with a grade of ‘C-’ or better, unless otherwise stated, with an overall 2.0 major GPA.

Students may not earn more than two unsatisfactory grades (U, D, D-, D+, or F) in any major coursework once admitted into the major at FSU.

## REQUIRED COURSES

### C grades or better needed

6 hours of Principles coursework

- ECO2013: Macroeconomics
- ECO2023: Microeconomics

6 hours of Supporting coursework

- MAC1105: College Algebra or higher
- STA2023: Business Stats or higher

- 12 hours of Core coursework (only 1 per term)

- ECO3203: Macroeconomic Theory
- ECO3101: Microeconomic Theory
- ECO3431: Analysis of Econ. Data
- ECO4421: Intro to Econometrics

- 15 hours of Elective coursework at the 3/4000 level

- Electives can be found on [FSU Class Search](#) using the SSECO Academic Organization code. Course prefixes include ECO, ECP, ECS

- Must complete a Calculus course, MAC 2233, 2311, or higher

## MINOR REQUIREMENT

Students are required to complete a minor in addition to major coursework. Major and minor hours cannot overlap, and minor hours are not allowed to overlap with General Education requirements.

### Requirements for a MINOR in Economics

15 hours of coursework, including ECO2013 & ECO2023 with a ‘C’ grade or higher and one core: ECO3101, 3203, 3431, or 4421. A 2.0 average GPA in the minor and “C-” or higher grades are required in all minor coursework. ECO2000 & ECO3042 will not apply to the minor. Only 6 hours of transfer credit may apply.
