



PUBLIC HEALTH

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

33 hours beyond General Education with a grade of 'C' or better in each course. 21 of these hours must be at the 3/4000 level. All major coursework must be selected from the [approved course list](#).

- It is strongly recommended that students complete a 2000-level Statistics course prior to entering the upper-division major
- **“C” grades or better needed for all major courses**

CORE COURSES (21 hours)

18 hours PHC core to include:

- PHC4101: Intro to Public Health
- PHC4030: Intro to Epidemiology
- PHC4157: Health Policy & Society
- PHC4470: Health Behavior and Health Promotion
- PHC4047: Intro to Environmental Epidemiology
- PHC4069: Biostatistics

3-4 hours Methods core chosen from the [approved list](#), including but not limited to:

- PHC 4721: Qualitative Methods for Public Health, GIS4421: GIS & Health, GIS4043/L: Geographic Info. Systems, GIS 4330: Florida GIS Applications
- Other methods courses as approved

ELECTIVE COURSES (12 hours)

- Elective courses must be chosen from the [approved course list](#) and must come from at least 2 separate departments. Students are able to customize their elective hours to meet their individual interests.
- Courses used to satisfy General Education requirements cannot be used towards the major.

MINOR REQUIREMENT

Students are required to complete a [minor](#) in addition to major coursework. Major and minor hours cannot overlap, and minor hours are not allowed to overlap with General Education requirements.
