Dear COSSPP Colleagues,



COSSPP Fiscal Year 2024 Awards

During Fiscal Year 2023-24, COSSPP faculty participated in 44 externally funded research projects with total awards of \$5.4 million; 23 of the 44 projects were new awards in FY24, and funding was received from Federal (49%), state (28%), and other (23%) entities.

COSSPP faculty participated in the development of 74 unique proposal submissions; these funding requests totaled \$44.8 million, and they targeted Federal (59%), State (9%) and Other (31%) entities.

Last Call to Apply: COSSPP Seeks Faculty Applicants for a Proposal Revision/Resubmission Grants Academy

The College of Social Sciences and Public Policy is investing in our faculty to support their grant-seeking efforts. This academic year, we have partnered with Hanover Research to support a

cohort of 8 faculty who are working on grant proposal resubmissions by putting them on the path towards submitting competitive proposals while equipping them with deeper grant writing skills and knowledge of the funding landscape. Participants will receive access to individualized counseling, proposal review services, and the wide array of trainings and other resources offered by Hanover Research (www.hanoverresearch.com).

We invite applications for these eight spots. Applicants are asked to submit their CV along with a maximum two page cover letter indicating their interest in being considered for the academy, a description of the proposal they will work on [including the topic, the state of the proposal with respect to the preparation and/or revision process, and which potential funder(s) you have identified as potential source(s) of funding support], and their commitment to putting in the necessary time and effort to submit a revised proposal.

A brownfield is a property where expansion, redevelopment or reuse may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant or contaminant.
